LPC 60 graduate semester hours, including a master's degree in counseling, from a university approved by the board that consists of 45 graduate semester hours distributed among 10 core categories (this includes a supervised practicum). Experiential Requirements: LCPC Licensed as an LPC or meets all requirements to be licensed as an LPC; and 4,000 hours of supervised clinical professional counseling experience under an approved clinical training plan, which includes 1,500 hours of direct client contact and 100 hours of clinical supervision (50 must be individual supervision).
