Experiential Requirements: 3400 hours of postgraduate supervised counseling experience, including 2,000 hours of direct client contact. 200 hours of supervision required (100 hours must be under the supervision of an LPC approved by the board). Graduate level internship hours may count toward the 4,000 hours.
