Goal (MDV): Prepare students to interpret the biblical writings in the Greek and/or Hebrew languages using critical exegetical tools and writing a hermeneutical and exegetical paper.

Goal (MBL & MBL/JCS): Instruct students to employ critical methods of exegesis from an informed theological/hermeneutical perspective for sound interpretation of the text.

Artifact: Research Paper (GBIB 561 OT Herm. & Exegesis-Hebrew; GBIB 581 NT Herm. & Exegesis-Greek)
