To locate a Hebrew word in a lexicon, it is necessary to know these three letters.



Verbs with "missing letters" are known as hollow root verbs.



The three letter root is designated by the Hebrew letters 22

is the 1st radical
is the 2nd radical
is the 3rd radical







The] is in the 1st or **>** position




The ¹ is in the 1st or ² position
