

The Subjunctive Mood

Unlike the indicative, which expresses reality, the subjunctive mood expresses possibility, probability, exhortation, and axiomatic concepts. It has no time significance, and uses η and ω as its connecting or variable vowels .

Present Active

1st Aorist Active

2nd Aorist Active

1. λάβω λάβωμεν
2. λάβης λάβητε
3. λάβη λάβωσι(ν)

1st Aorist Passive

1. λυθῶ λυθῶμεν
2. λυθῆς λυθῆτε
3. λυθῆ λυθῶσι(ν)

2nd Aorist Passive

1. γραφῶ γραφῶμεν
2. γραφῆς γραφῆτε
3. γραφῆ γραφῶσι(ν)
